

1200 Comfort Quilt

Use 30 40 inch x 2 ½ inch strips. Sew them together to make one 1200 inch strip. Cut about 20 inches off of one end only to stagger the seams when making rows.

Sew the strip to itself along one long edge. Cut apart just before you get to the end and finish the seam. You will have a long strip slightly less than 4.5 x 600 inches. There's no need to press at this step. Repeat three more times to get 32.5 x 75 inches. Trim to 32.5 x 54 inches. Press seams to one side. Cut the remainder into five inch strips, piece to fit and sew along the sides to make 42 x 54, the standard comfort quilt size.



It will be a little bit longer than the illustration. You can join the strips diagonally as in the picture or straight.
